**RECYCLE GUIDELINES
PLEASE RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**

MATERIAL	WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED	PREPARATION	MATERIAL THAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED
Glass	Clear, brown, amber or green glass from beverage bottles and food jars	Rinse bottles and jars. Do not break glass.	Broken glass, window glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, ceramics, mirrors, tempered glass, Pyrex type ovenware.
Aluminum, Steel and Bi-Metal Cans	Aluminum, steel and/or bi-metal food cans, EMPTY aerosol cans, soft drink and beer cans, clean foil containers	Rinse cans (crush if spaced is needed).	Aluminum siding, toys, lawn furniture, clothes hangers, paint cans, cans with food inside, greasy foil, scrap metals, screws, nuts, etc.
Plastics (PETE, HDPE, V, LDPE, PP and PS) #1 through #7 Stamped on bottom	Clear plastic milk, soda and water bottles, butter and cottage cheese containers, baby wipe containers, detergent, bleach and softener bottles/jugs, shampoo bottles.	Rinse, remove and discard lids in garbage (crush bottles if space is needed). If container is greasy, wipe out with soapy water and rinse.	No Styrofoam peanuts, and blocks, loose plastic bags, plastic plant pots, foam plastic egg cartons, plastic wrap, toys, lawn furniture, pesticide or herbicide bottles, antifreeze.
Newsprint & Magazines	Anything printed on newsprint paper (black or colored inks); phonebooks and magazines	Place newsprint in a paper grocery bag or bundle and tie. Place on top of recyclables in cart.	DO NOT place newspapers outside of cart on wet days.
Cardboard and Other Papers	Clean Corrugated and pressed cardboard, cereal, shoe, tissue boxes; white office paper; magazines, ad inserts, junk mail including envelopes; paper bags	Place in a paper grocery bag or bundle and tie. Place on top of recyclables in cart.	Pizza boxes (place in garbage); waxed papers; hardback books, juice boxes; cardboard milk cartons; take-out food containers
