**Notice to Customers:**

Under mandate of the State Department of Environmental Protection, all new service connections made to the Authority's water system shall have a backflow prevention device and thermal expansion tank installed before installation of water service.

Similarly, when existing properties are sold, the **seller and/or buyer** must have a backflow prevention device installed before the initiation of water service. Also required is a non-removable hose bibb vacuum breaker at all hose connections. The authority recommends a type for cold climates. A thermal expansion device is also required.

**TYPE OF DEVICES THAT MUST BE INSTALLED:** Residential dual check valve or commercial double check valve/RPZ valve, non-removal hose bibb and thermal expansion device.
